

SalzburgerLand Card Terms and Conditions



1. Definition:

The SalzburgerLand Card, hereinafter referred to as the SLCard, is the tourist all-inclusive card of SalzburgerLand Tourismus Ges.m.b.H., hereinafter referred to as SalzburgerLand Tourism, entitling the holder for a one-time purchase price to avail him-/herself of those services contractually agreed upon by SL-Card partner entities. These services are defined in the SL-Card participation agreements for partner entities and described in the SL-Card brochure which appears every two years.

2. Scope of services:

All SL-Card partner entities have obligated themselves to make available their SL-Card services within the specified term of validity during their usual hours of business and in keeping with their general terms of carriage and/or business, without restriction with respect to time and quantity, as well as to their full extent with regard to quality and quantity. Those SL-Card partner entities for whom an exemption has been stipulated, define the scope of their services in the SLCard brochure. SalzburgerLand Tourism assumes no liability for the services provided by SL-Card partner entities.

3. Toll roads:

When using passes or scenic roads which charge a toll for their use and are SL-Card partners, each of the vehicle occupants must possess an SL-Card, otherwise a proportionate fee for the use of said road will be charged

4. Validity

The SL-Card is non-transferable and is valid only between May 1 and October 26, 2009/10 in combination with a photo ID and only when the first and last names of the card holder, as well as the last date of validity, are clearly entered.

6. Prices

The SL-Card is sold 2009/10 at the following prices incl. VAT:

Prices which partner entities charge for admission may be subject to adjustments. This has no influence on the sales prices of the SL-Card itself.

7. Children's discounts:

The discounted rate applies to children between the ages of 6 and 15. The determining factor is the age of the child at the commencement of the vacation. For the third child or more of a family, there exists the right to free use of contractualized SL-Card services. For the third child or more of a family, free SL-Cards (Card type F) will be issued. No Cards will be issued to children under age 6, nor will they be required to present a ticket of any kind. Important: At some partner entities, children under age 6 and children without a SalzburgerLand Card must pay the prevailing price (please refer to the current SL-Card brochure). The family provision only applies to those children who procure their SL-Card in the company of at least one adult person, a person to whom they are either related or who is their legal guardian.

8. Sales outlets

Sales outlets are those tourist authorities, hotels, partner entities and other businesses who have been authorized by SalzburgerLand Tourism.

9. Usage:

At the time of admission to an SL-Card partner entity where an electronic scanning device is operated, the holder of the Card must insert it into the device for scanning and registration. When gaining admission to a partner entity without an electronic scanning device, details are logged in writing by a control person using a standardized list. In order to use the public buses of the Salzburg Transit Authority within the validity framework stipulated in the 24-hour SalzburgCard which is integrated in the SL-Card, the SLCard must be presented to ticket inspectors, hereby the date and time of first use within Salzburg City must be clearly and legibly entered in the space prescribed for that purpose.

10. Misuse:

Any misuse of the SL-Card, especially its use by people who are not entitled to do so, will lead to its confiscation without compensation and the immediate termination of the Card's validity.

11. Damage to the Card:

SalzburgerLand Tourism is liable only for damage to or technical defects of this chip card, or of electronic scanning equipment, in so far as it has been handled appropriately. If, as a consequence of which, admission is not possible, the partner entity in question will issue a substitute admission ticket and the SL-Card holder will be registered in writing. Should the Card be damaged, the holder is requested to find the nearest SL-Card sales outlet as quickly as possible in order to exchange it for a new chip card.

12. Loss

In the event of theft or loss, SalzburgerLand Tourism assumes no liability and there exists no right to replacement of the Card, nor to reimbursement of the original purchase price.

13. Closure of Partner entities:

In the event of temporary closure of partner entities during the SL-Card season, none of the purchase price will be refunded.

14. Liability

SL-Card partner entities bear sole legal responsibility for the operation of their respective businesses. Any and all liability with respect to SL-Card holders is this on the basis of contractual or legal provisions, for incidents during a visit to, or use of a partner entity, therefore affects exclusively that partner entity at which the incident occurred. No liability exists with respect to other partner entities or SalzburgerLand Tourism.

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
